

24-Month STEM OPT Extension

This document is meant to serve as an overview and outline the steps for the STEM OPT Extension application process.

Please refer to the <u>Study in the States STEM OPT Hub</u> for complete information.

Eligibility

- ⇒ F-1 students approved for standard Post-Completion Optional Practical Training based on a STEM (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) field that appears on the <u>DHS STEM-Designated Degree Program List</u> can apply to USCIS for a 24-month extension of post-completion OPT (for a total eligibility of up to 36 months.)
- \Rightarrow The student must have a job or job offer from an employer registered in the <u>E-Verify system</u>.
- \Rightarrow A student whose period of standard post-completion OPT has already expired is ineligible to apply for the STEM OPT extension.
- ⇒ A minor field of study cannot serve as the basis for a 24-month STEM OPT extension.
- ⇒ An individual is eligible for two 24-month STEM OPT extensions, each after a higher level degree has been obtained.

When to apply

The student must apply for the STEM OPT extension before their standard period of post-completion OPT expires, but no earlier than 90 days before the end date on the EAD.

While application is pending:

- ullet If a student's regular post-completion OPT expires after a STEM OPT <u>I-765</u> is properly and timely filed, the student's employment authorization is considered automatically extended for up to 180 days while the STEM OPT application is pending.
- Travel is not recommended for students who are in a 180-day period of interim employment while the STEM OPT extension is pending.

Employment Authorization Document (EAD) and dates:

- The employment authorization period for the 24-month OPT extension begins the day after the expiration of the initial post-completion OPT employment authorization and ends 24 months thereafter, regardless of the date the actual extension is approved.
- USCIS will issue a new EAD reflecting STEM OPT extension dates.

	2	DSO reviews the Form I-983 and determines that it is complete, signed, and addresses all program requirements
	3	DSO updates the student's SEVIS record and issues a new Form I-20 with a recommendation for the 24-month STEM OPT extension
	4	DSO mails the STEM OPT I-20 to the address provided on the STEM Extension Request Form

		<u>Form I-765</u>
		\Rightarrow Item #3: If you might move, use an address that will not change (such as employer, or LETU Office of Global Initiatives.) Mail from USCIS is <u>not</u> forwarded by the Postal Service.
		\Rightarrow Item #16: Eligibility code for the 17-month STEM OPT extension is (c)(3)(C)
		\Rightarrow Make sure you sign the Form I-765
		Personal check or money order for \$410 (fee is subject to change) payable to "Department of Homeland Security" with I-94 number written on the check / credit card if paying online
		Two identical passport photos with name and I-94 number written on back in pencil or felt pen / digital photo if submitting online $\frac{1}{2}$
		Copy/scan of <u>I-94</u>
		Copy/scan of signed STEM OPT I-20 from OGI
		Copy/scan of STEM degree (transcript)
		Copy/scan of EAD card (front and back)
		Letter from employer that includes job duties and specifies full-time employment
		Copy/scan of passport picture page
		Copy/scan of visa
STEP	THE	EE: Submit application & supporting documents to USCIS
		Make a copy of the entire application (for your records) before you submit it to USCIS
		Documents must be mailed/submitted within 60 days of the DSO's recommendation in SEVIS and before the expiration of the current post-completion OPT
		Submit the application to <u>USCIS Lockbox</u> with jurisdiction over the address you list on the I-765

Reporting Requirements:

Throughout the STEM OPT extension period, the student, employer/s, and school must comply with all reporting, training, supervision, evaluation, wage, documentation, and other obligations specified in the regulations and on Form I-983.
